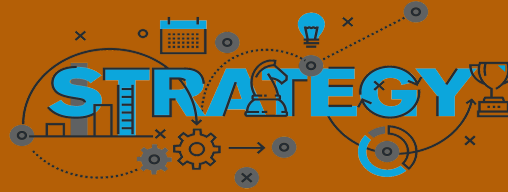




THE DR. RONALD McNAIR CLUB: READING SUPPORT & STEM MENTORSHIP

Started in 2018, The Dr. Ronald McNair Club (or “The McNair Club”) is a 6 to 12 month, “STEM-Mentor” program designed to provide interested McNair HS students and beyond – from low-income, traditionally disadvantaged backgrounds – typically underrepresented in STEM majors – supplementary training to strengthen their reading skills and further demonstrate scientific rigor, develop confidence, and pursue their interest in STEM fields – especially in physics, aeronautical, and agricultural science. **The program takes place after school and is limited to 50 students for maximum impact.** The McNair Club was inspired by the life of Dr. Ronald McNair, PhD and [The McNair Scholars Program](#)



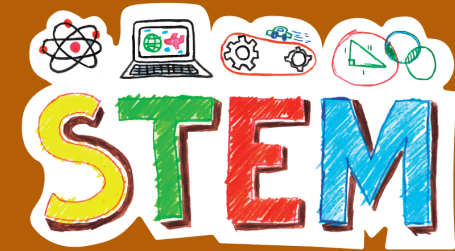
WHY THE DR. McNAIR CLUB?

- **EMPHASIS ON READING & MATH**

Culturally-relevant solutions for improving low-income, traditionally disadvantaged student’s academic comprehension of STEM and ELA/Reading subjects.

We inspire low-income, traditionally disadvantaged students to further demonstrate scientific rigor, develop confidence, and pursue their interests (and careers) in STEM fields -- especially in physics, aeronautical, and agricultural science.

students will need to commit

HOW STUDENTS ARE SELECTED INTO THE CLUB

The McNair Club Advisor/Team meets with
school's STEM teachers -- with the largest
populations of low-income, traditionally
disadvantaged students -- to introduce them
to The McNair Club Program.

After McNair Club Advisor shares info about
The McNair Club, if the teacher(s) are
interested in supporting, they can refer
students -- who have a genuine interest in
pursuing a career in STEM -- over to apply.
*(Teacher-referred students will be given
priority during the application review process.)*

McNair Club Applicants considered for
program will need to interview to join the
club. Acceptance to club will be based on
applicant's: Scholarship, Leadership, Service,
& Faith in One's ability to achieve.
